We are helping to protect more than 46 million acres of some of the most ecologically important coastlines, ocean habitat, wetlands, islands, and wildlife-filled coastal wilderness in the world. MANGROVES

178,000

mangroves planted in the world's most pristine gray whale breeding lagoon, storing up to 7 million tons of carbon each year and creating hundreds of local jobs.



CORAL REEFS

38 MILLION

acres of sensitive coral reef habitat protected in the Mexican Pacific and 220 buoys installed to safeguard reefs from anchoring ships.



WILDLANDS

51,939

acres of desert wilderness and 39.5 miles of coastlines protected in the WILDCOAST Valle de los Cirios Coastal Reserve.

SEA TURTLES

123 MILLION

olive ridley sea turtle eggs hatched on 22.5 miles of protected coastlines in Oaxaca, Mexico.

MPAS

545,280

acres of Marine Protected Areas off California's coast that WILDCOAST protects and conserves through our Marine Monitor (M2) RADAR units and community science programs.



WETLANDS

3,000

metric tons of carbon dioxide sequestered in wetlands we are restoring throughout San Diego County, equating to 250K gallons of gas consumed.



MARINE DEBRIS

200,000

lbs of plastic and debris prevented from reaching the Pacific Ocean via our trash boom, the first-ever solid waste retention system in Mexico.
